

Expectations of the Child and Family

1. Participate in the first Child & Family Team Meeting (CFTM) within 14 days from approval
2. Participate in the CFTM at LEAST every 30 days
3. Develop a Crisis and Safety Plan with the team
4. Partner with the Child and Family Team
5. To discuss the difficult issues and needs that have brought you to the project.

CBAY - Community Based Alternatives for Youth

What is CBAY

- ◆ A waiver - a federal designation allowing states to "waive" certain portions of Medicaid law in order to provide home and community based services to individuals who would otherwise require institutional care.
- ◆ Funding source to support additional services and supports not covered by Medicaid State plan



The Purpose of CBAY



- ◆ To allow youth to "waive" institutional care at the PRTF and be served in the community by core and specialty providers, **supplemented** with waiver services.
- ◆ To produce better outcomes for youth and families by keeping them together and providing the skills they need to succeed

Who We Serve

- ◆ Medicaid-eligible youth through age 21
- ◆ Have a DSM-IV-TR (or most current) Axis I diagnosis
- ◆ Meet the level of care for the Psychiatric Residential Treatment Facility (PRTF)
- ◆ Can be currently in the PRTF or in the community



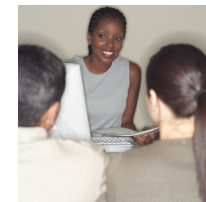
Services Provided

CBAY offers children and family teams the following services to supplement the Medicaid State Plan Services:

- ◆ Care Management
- ◆ Supported Employment
- ◆ Community Transition Services
- ◆ Family Training & Supports
- ◆ Wraparound Services— Unskilled
- ◆ Consultative Clinical & Therapeutic Services
- ◆ Respite
- ◆ Community Guide
- ◆ Transportation
- ◆ Customized Goods & Services
- ◆ Financial Support Services

What is High Fidelity Wraparound?

- ◆ The family-driven, team approach to planning processed utilized by the CBAY project through the Care Management Entity of your choice to develop your plan
- ◆ A process that identifies the unique needs of each child, working closely with the family to develop the skills and resources to care for the child.
- ◆ A process that requires child and family teams (all people that know the child best and work with the child and family and all others the family wants on the team) to meet at LEAST monthly to develop, implement and monitor the action plan.



At the First Meeting:

- ◆ We will identify your family strengths and needs and talk about your goals for your family.
- ◆ We will talk about who you feel most comfortable with attending meetings ... you decide who is there. It can be family, friends, agency workers, anyone you want!
